Sunday 29 Sept
7:00 A.M.

Won't be able to write diary letter today as
we are "standing to" waiting to again (ordnance)
move forward from where we spent the
night.

We moved forward up on Thursday P.M.
and have been driving the Hum. back
Friday & Saturday and hope to make
him go much further today. A
little rain yesterday but today clear
a beautiful sunrise. We had stables in
dash at 4:30.

Palmer's letter Sept 9 rec. (but not the
one he speaks of about my returning which
he wrote before it)

Yours truly of Sept 3rd & 4th from Bernal

Alice left 6th 10th from Larnard
and Elmer left 9th, all so welcome
Have sent them on to Sarah as cannot
carry much more as we have maps of
country east now to carry

Lost a few horses on Friday and
yesterday 3 officers wounded including
Major Ferris and about a dozen men
and as many horses, principally from
shell fire whilst waiting pretty close
up behind our infantry.

I am very well and enjoying the show
and only hope it may hasten the end.

The Carl's has done well again and
is not through yet. The news from all
our seems good. Although we don't get
much. Will write diary as soon as possible
