Dear Ibb & Wood,-

Your dear mother and I got home at midnight Thursday after a very pleasant two weeks at Kingsville on the Lake. It is an awfully quiet place with the exception of Saturday and Sunday when Detroit and Windsor people come to spend the week end. However, these all proved very nice and quiet people, several exceptionally so. Too dull a place for those wanting pleasure.

We were both very much improved by the rest, especially myself. I found things had gone on very well in our output of shells which I will detail in my weekly letter. We also are now quite busy in Boiler Shop having got order for, 72" Boilers the day before I left.

- 2 - 72" x 16' Industrial School, London
- 1 - 72" x 12' Daly & Morin, Lachine, P.Q.

We had to buy the heads and a few plates (4 1/2") to make up the batch. This takes all the wide 9 foot plates 19 feet long we had. I hope to get a business letter off to you on Monday.
