MONDAY

March 12th.

To-day there were very few settlements, and the ones received were small.

Shipped to-day to Three Rivers Industrial Company 36 x 10 Boiler. A tank to John A. Gordon 24" x 36". Car of shells containing 990.

Mar.13th,

Received from the Dept. Militia, cheque for Sterilizer supplied Kingston Camp \$338.00.

Mar.14th.

Rev. Sisters Grey Nuns, Ottawa paid \$669.00, 50% on boiler supplied them. Eggett & Co. paid \$2176.00 being 75% of Technical school boilers. Several small settlements amounting to about \$150.00.

Mar.15th.

Mr. Morgan not feeling ~~awa~~ well to-day and remained home.

Received from British War Office on accounts of boilers \$5100.00. From the I.M.B. \$3946.97.

Shipped car of shells to-day 996. Also received a few small settlements.

Mr. Morgan is still away, expected back in morning.

March 16th.

Shipped Darling Bros. 36 x 72" tank, also shipped Goodyear Tire & Rubber Co. 34 x 8 ft. tank. Delivered to London Soap Co. S.H. 72 x 18 Boiler we purchased from Woodstock Thames Valley Rly.

Shipped car of shells to-day containing 990.

Paid \$4393.00 to 220 men including \$1881.00 piece work.

Mr. Morgan is back to-day.

Deducted for Red Cross this week \$111.30.

Received from Mr. Evans a number of accounts to charge for sundry sales including 8 Up. Boiler for Mail Publishing Company, 11 x 10 Clipper Engine shipped and charged to P.S.I. Brick & Tile Co. This being one of the Vancouver engines returned.

Received an order from Calgary for No.5 Dakin Heater 50" x 12 ft. We are trying to get him to accept the Bow Island Heater we have had on hand for several years originally made for Mueller of Carnia, the price of No.5 was sold for was \$525.00 F.O.B. London.

Mr. Morgan not feeling well and did not come back this P.M.

We are sorry that your father is still away.

We have arranged with Sir George to take up Mrs. Fitzgerald's stock and have paid 50% in to him and will pay the balance on the 22nd.

We received contract from the I.M.B. for our signature for 36,000 60 Pr. Mark VII shells.

The engine and boiler section met in Toronto to discuss prices on boilers, we were not able to attend but they decided on selling 25 on list for boiler and fixtures, 50% on list for naked boilers.

March 13th.

Had a heavy fall of snow last night, the heaviest of the season 8".
The I.M.B. remitted us \$44.55. Delmer Cheese Co. 206.74. F. & E.S.
Stephenson \$361.00 and several other smaller payments amounting to
some \$300.00.

Our scrap shell turnings and shell ends for the month of February
ran over \$2300.00, nearly 250 tons.

TUESDAY
March 6th.

Shipped carload of shells to-day containing 996.
Received from T. DeGruchy payment for boiler \$704.88. Billings &
Flemming on past due notes \$155.70. Several other smaller payments
amounting to \$200.00.

WEDNESDAY
March 7th.

Rain and slush. Wettlaufer Bros. paid us \$346.06 for boiler.
A few minor accounts paid to-day amount to \$100.00.

THURSDAY
March 8th.

Shipped car of shells containing 990 to-day, also shipped 6 H.P.
Upright to Wolfe, Sayer & Heller, \$206.80.

Supplied quantity of extras to British War Office in way of
man and handhole gaskets, fusible, plugs, etc, amounting to \$411.28.
Received from I.M.B. cheque for \$8072.51, also British War Office
for Boilers \$2550.00, several smaller settlements amounting to about
\$300.00

FRIDAY
March 9th.

Very few settlements in to-day but would amount to about \$200.00.
Paid \$4309. to 214 men including \$1776.00 piece work. Deducted for
Red Cross subscriptions \$169.70, this makes about 2/3 of the amount
subscribed paid in.

SATURDAY
March 10th.

The New York & Dominion Corp. paid \$600.00 being the final 50% on the
McCormick engine sold them. De Laval Company paid \$226.70. I.M.B.
paid \$494.90, this amount is for loading a car of copper turnings, they
allow us for handling same into car 3/4 lb. A few smaller payments
amounting to about \$100.00.

Your father has been away from the office since Wednesday afternoon
Received \$1000.00 from imp. for 6 H.P. Upright boiler.
