Dr. E. G. D. Murray was born in Johannesburg, South Africa. He received training at Cambridge University and Bartholomew's Hospital. He was Professor of Bacteriology and Immunology at McGill University and elected a fellow of the Royal Society of Canada in 1955. He also taught as a professor at the Medical Department at Western University until his death in 1964. This fonds contains certificates, photographs and notebooks and lecture notes from Dr. Murray.
