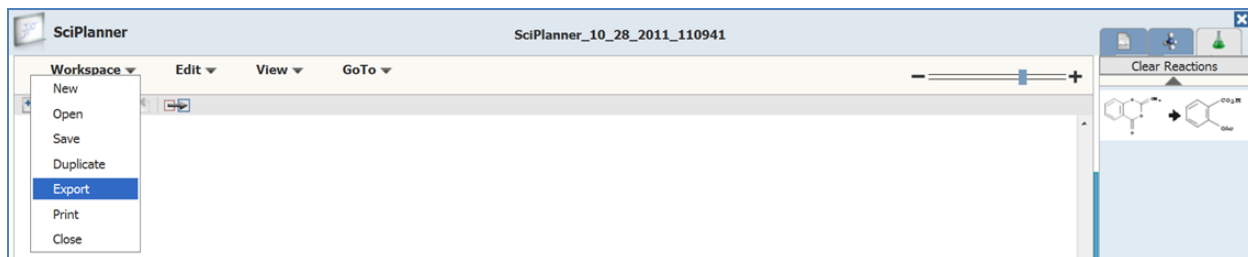


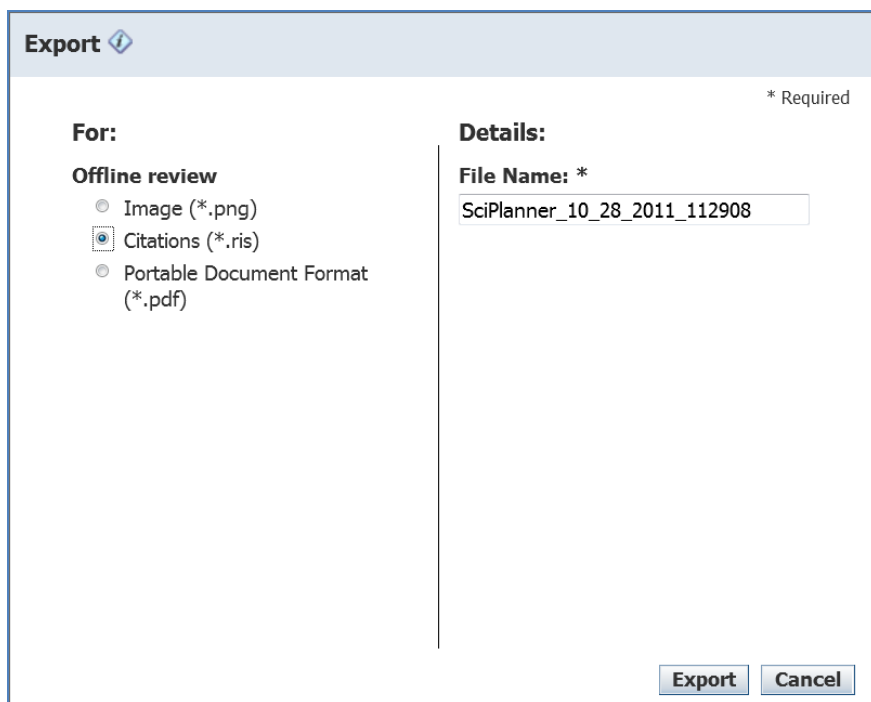
Importing References from SciPlanner (Workspace of SciFinder) into RefWorks

In SciFinder

1. Completed your synthesis plan
2. Click **Export** from the **Workspace** drop menu



3. Choose **Citations (*.ris)** and assign a file name



4. Click **Export** save to your desktop.

In RefWorks

1. Select **References/Import** from the tool bar
2. Select **Desktop Biblio. Mgt. Software** as the **Import Filter/Data Source**
3. Choose **Reference Manager (RIS Format)**

4. **Select Text File – Browse** to find your saved .ris document
5. **Import into Folder** to your target folder
6. Click on **Import**
