1. Conduct a search.
2. Mark appropriate records by clicking on **Add to Folder** icon for each desired record.

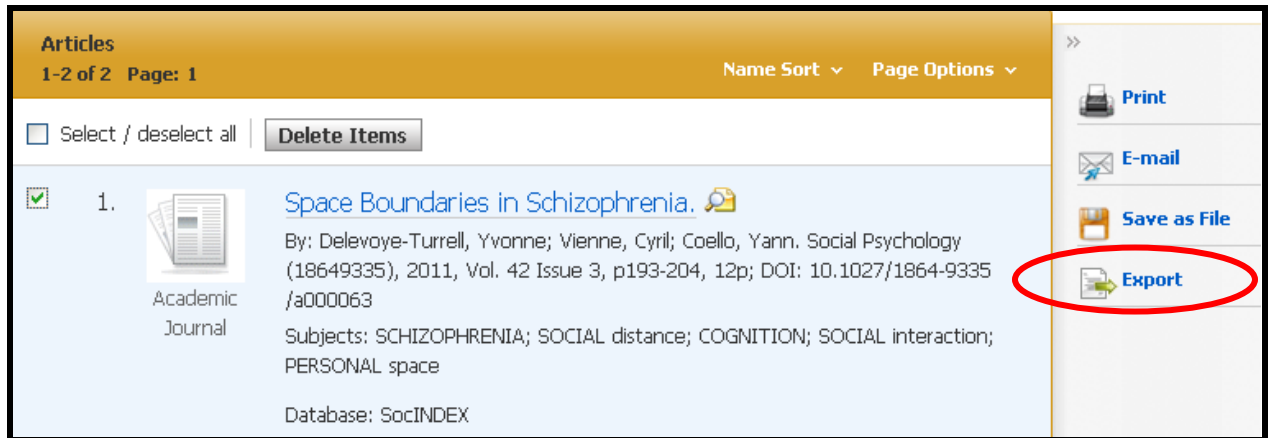

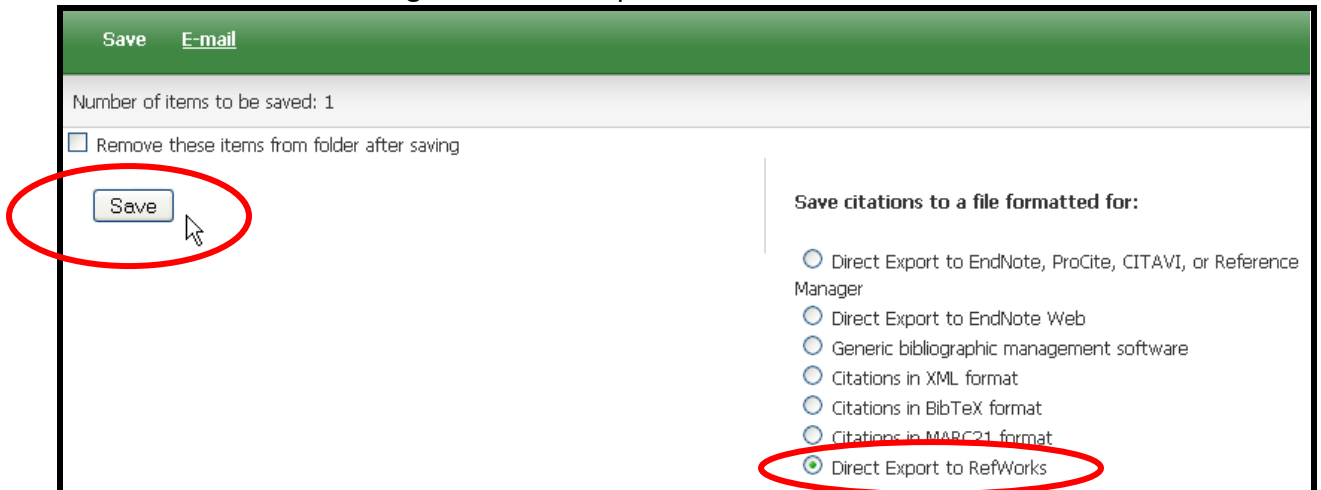

4. **Select** the results you want to export (single or multiple) and click on the **Export** icon on the right of the screen.



5. Click the radio button in front of **Direct Export to RefWorks**.
6. Click the **Save** button to begin the direct export.



Note:

Uncheck the **Remove these items from folder after saving** option, if you want items to remain in the folder after performing the export function.

7. Log into your **RefWorks** account when prompted and wait for the **Import Completed** message
8. Your records should appear in the **Last Imported Folder**.
