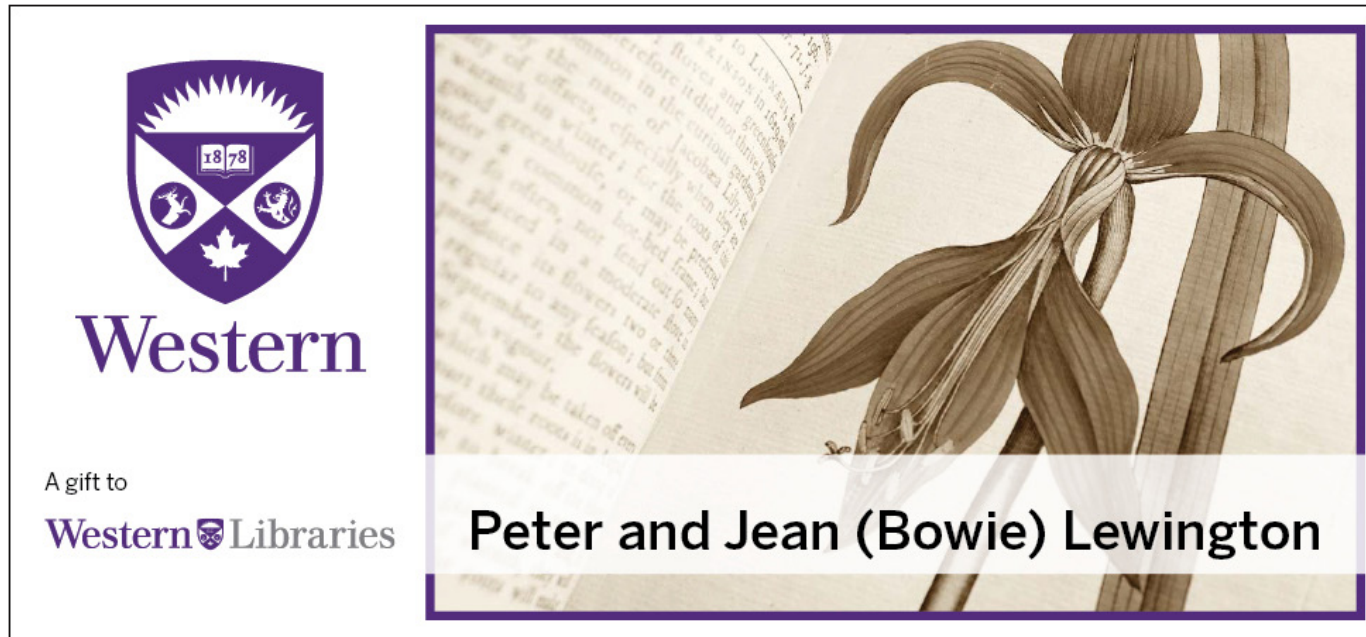


Peter and Jean (Bowie) Lewington
