Victor Lauriston Collection Listing

<u>VICTOR LAURISTON COLLECTION</u>

Victor Lauriston, a noted Canadian Author, historian and journalist, was born on October 16, 1881 at Fletcher, Ontario. He was formerly known as William Edward Park, and was the son of Robert Park, a school inspector for Goderich. Lauriston attended school in Goderich and entered Osgoode Hall in Toronto for a short time before becoming a reporter for the Chatham Planet and News in 1904. In 1908 he became aditor of the Chatham News but resigned in 1913 to become a freelance journalist.

As an Author, Lauriston wrote and published five books: Romantic Kent (1952), Lambton County's Hundred Years (1949), Postcript to a Poet (1941), The Twenty-First Burr (1922), Inglorious Milton (1934). and Arthur Stringer: Son of the North (1941). He also wrote many articles and serials for magazines in Canada, the U. S. and Britain. From 1913, Lauriston was the correspondent of the Oil and Gas Journal and the official reporter of the Natural Gas and Petroleum Association of Canada from its organization in June 1919.

In 1943, Victor Lauriston returned to the Chatham News as a special writer and his "Maybe I'm Wrong" column became a regular feature.

Victor Lauriston was also a member of several community organizations and clubs. He was a member of the Chatham Board of Education for many years, a member Canadian Author's Association since 1921, a member of the Ontario Historical Society, and a member of the Macaulay Club.

On September 25, 1907, Victor Lauriston married Emily Grace Carry and they had seven children; Dorothy Mary Lauriston (Steinke), Laura Grace Lauriston (Johns), Gloria Margaret Lauriston (Thomson), Vida Winnifred Lauriston (Miller), Wilfrid Maitland Lauriston, Arthur Carlos Lauriston, and Archie John Lauriston. Victor Lauriston changed his name legally on Apr. 29, 1918 from William Edward Park, but he had been using Victor Lauriston in his literary work and business matters since 1904. Lauriston died at Chatham Ontario on October 18, 1973.
