Biographical Sketch/Administrative History

Margaret Fullerton: Margaret Fullerton (1909-1991) was a municipal politician and London's first female city councillor.

Born in 1909 as Margaret Thomson, she completed her bachelor's degree at the University of Western Ontario and went on to get her teaching degree from the College of Education In Toronto. After completing her education, she taught Latin and English at London's Central Collegiate. Throughout her young adult years, Fullerton was an avid diarist, recording much of her daily life from her years as a student to her early career as a teacher.

Fullerton entered municipal politics in 1953 as ward 2 alderman after a successful campaign supported by London's Council of Women. During her career as a municipal politician, Fullerton served on the Board of Control, was vice-president of the London Centennial Committee and chair of the London Historical Sites and Museum Committee. Fullerton was also instrumental in repealing the clause in the procedural by-law that barred married women from working at City Hall. While Fullerton's career was largely focused in London, she made an attempt to enter federal politics, running as the London Liberal candidate in the 1965 federal election. She lost the race to Progressive Conservative, John Irvine, and returned to municipal politics. In 1968, Fullerton served as a member of the Canadian delegation to the 21st session of the United Nations, serving on the Trusteeship and Colonialism committee. She was defeated in her 1969 bid for controller and following a hiatus from municipal politics, returned to London's city council as a controller in 1971 to replace Jack Irvine who resigned. Her return to municipal politics was brief as only 10 days later, Fullerton accepted a position on the Pension Review Board. While in Ottawa, she also served on the board of directors of the Ottawa Civil Service Recreation Association.

After retiring from public service in 1978, Margaret Fullerton returned to London where she died in 1991.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of the records created and acquired by Margaret Fullerton relating to both her personal life and political career. Included are files for various municipal projects and events, records relating to Fullerton's federal public service, campaign materials, photographs, newspaper clippings and scrapbooks. Personal records relate to Fullerton's education, speeches that she gave and include various biographical records as well as a series of diaries, travel diaries and a dream log.

Scope and Content

Series consists of records relating to Margaret Fullerton's work in London municipal politics as alderman, controller and member of various committees. Included are files for various projects that Fullerton was involved in such as the organization of the London Centennial celebrations, the building of city hall and centennial hall, the changes made to the by-law prohibiting married women from working at city hall, and her work relating to heritage as well as records relating to her various appointments to city council. Records include reports, correspondence, building plans, photographs, newspaper clippings and promotional materials for events.

Scope and Content

Series consists of the personal records of Margaret Fullerton, documenting her education, travels and speaking engagements. Education records include examination certificates, report forms, a university registration permit and several essays that she submitted for university English courses. Also included are notes and a speech about her year abroad in London, England in 1953 as well as the speech "New Experiences in Education" that she and her husband Edwin gave together after returning from their year abroad. Other records include correspondence and memoir style notes written by Margaret Fullerton in her later years, reflecting on her life and travels.

Also included are travel diaries about trips to Europe and a dream log.
