## Biographical Sketch/Administrative History

Macallum, Archibald Byron, Sr.: Dr. Archibald B. McCallum Senior was brother to fellow doctor Hugh McCallum and father to A. Bruce McCallum Jr., also a doctor. He was born April 7, 1858 in Belmont Canada West. He graduated from the University of Toronto and for a time was Professor of Biochemistry at McGill University. He changed his last name from 'McCallum' to 'MacCallum' at some point throughout his career.
