Dr. John Heber Fisher fonds. 1924-1980

Scope and Content

Dr. Fisher was born in Glanworth near London, Ontario in 1899 and graduated from Western's Medical School in 1922. He served as a Private with the No. 11 Canadian Stationary Hospital in 1918-19. He interned at Victoria Hospital while in his final year of study and upon graduation began a career in pathology and bacteriology at Western, which lasted for forty-three years. This fonds contains certificates, photographs, biographical information, correspondence and lecture materials belonging to Dr. Fisher.
