Dr. Hugh Alexander McCallum fonds. 1887-1921

Scope and Content

This fonds contains certificates, photographs and biographical records for Dr. Hugh Alexander McCallum. McCallum, born in 1860 is the brother of fellow doctor, A. B. McCallum Sn. He attended St. Thomas Collegiate before Western's Medical School from 1883-1886, where he graduated as gold medalist. In 1913 he was elected president of the Ontario Medical Association and Dean of Medicine at Western. McCallum died in 1921 of pneumonia.
