Scope and Content

Dr. A. Bruce McCallum, son of Dr. Archibald B. Macallum was born in Cornwall, Ontario in 1885. He graduated from the University of Toronto in 1909 with an M.B. and an M.D. in 1910. He then went on to teach as a fellow in biochemistry at Harvard University from 1909-1912. A. B. McCallum was appointed Dean of Medicine in 1927 by the Board of Governors after being the Professor of Biochemistry since 1924 at Western. He resigned as Dean in 1934 but carried on with his position as Professor of Biochemistry. This fond contains certificates, photographs and biographical records pertaining to Dr. A. Bruce McCallum.
