Dr. John A. Macgregor fonds. 1892-1955

Scope and Content

Dr. Macgregor was born in 1872 and graduated from the Medical School at Western in 1892. Soon after he started a rural practice in Kent Bridge near Chatham, Ontario and then moved to Minden, Nebraska. He moved to London in 1904 and started teaching pathology and bacteriology. He retired from the Faculty of Medicine at Western in 1925 and died in 1939. This fonds contains Dr. Macgregor's certicates, photograph and a plaque.
