Scope and Content

This series contains 7 prescription notebooks belonging to Dr. Newell. The first five books dated between 1878-1888 indicate Newell had his practice around Wyoming, Ontario, while the last two books between 1894-95 indicate he was practicing medicine around Watford, Ontario. *Restrictions*
