Administrative History

Originally founded as the Women's Morning Music Club, the Women's Music Club of London was established in 1894 by Louisa Carling, daughter of Sir John Carling. The club changed its name in 1903. Steered by its first president, Mrs. Sophia Labatt, the Women's Music Club worked to promote "the love and study of good music by hearing artists in concert." In addition to actively supporting local arts and culture, the Women's Music Club established a scholarship at the University of Western Ontario and did fundraising for various charitable organizations in the London area.

In the first 15 years of operation, membership grew to almost 150. There was an afternoon recital every month, and two social evenings and two formal concerts each year. In the 1922 season, the club began giving more local artist and student artist concerts. By 1945 the club had 1,500 members. Some notable Canadians who performed at Women's Music Club concerts were Flora Goulden, Harry Adaskin, members of the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, and the Hart House String Quartet. Performances were held in schools and halls throughout London.

The 70th anniversary of the Women's Music Club was held on September 29, 1963. The Women's Music Club ceased operations sometime after 1965.

Scope and Content
