Michael Niederman Collection

In order to improve access to more of the existing holdings of Western Archives copies of a number of preliminary finding aids are being made available. These preliminary finding aids, some of which were prepared many years ago, vary in degrees of completeness, detail and accuracy. Some provide only basic box listings of the contents of a fonds or a collection, while others provide additional background material. All are intended to be the starting point for access to the records and they should not be considered a definitive source of information on the full nature and contents of the fonds or collection. The Michael Niederman Collection can best be described as London ephemera. It contains numerous announcements for band appearances, business events, and organizations; notices and publications for galleries and exhibitions, advertisements and other miscellaneous papers from the London area in the 1970's thru 1980's; publications from the Applegarth Follies printer and book layouts; booklets of poetry and art displays; early postcards from the early 1920's and various historical material from London and Middlesex County. The collection is arranged into files under general subject headings. The order has been changed slightly since the original organization. Refer to the new inventory which follows.
