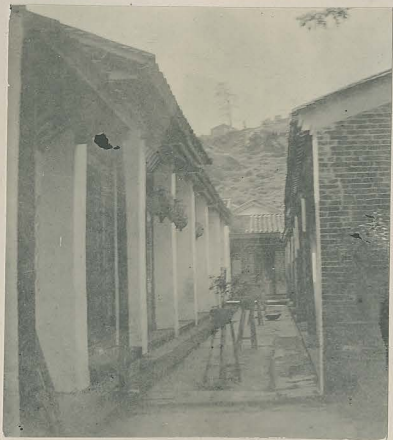

Shwe Dagon Pagoda Rangoon Burma. Feb 25. 1898

a solid brick pagoda covered with gold leaf. The "Spire" is gold plated & encased by jewels & is 370 feet in height. It contains actual relics of Gautama & of the 3 previous Buddhas. It stands on a mound & is ascended by 4 flights of stairs on the outer edge of the terrace surrounding the main pagoda are hundreds of small shrines, tall posts with long streamers of paper fastened to bamboos covered with prayers & multitudes of bells of all sizes. Buddhists say the shrine was erected 1500 B.C. 588 B.C. was a sacred spot for centuries before.

3rd largest bell in the world weighing 4 1/2 tons raised from the Irrawaddy by the Burmese after it had been lost here by the English & restored to its original position.

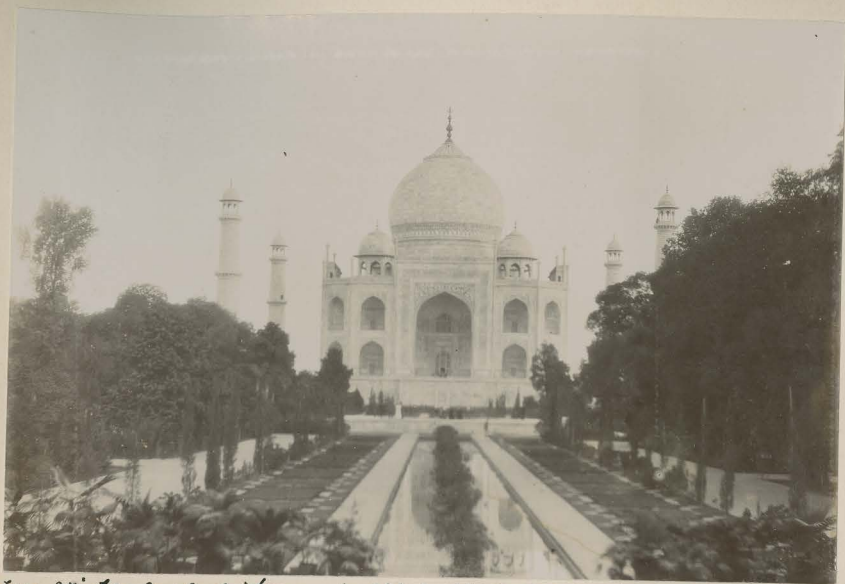

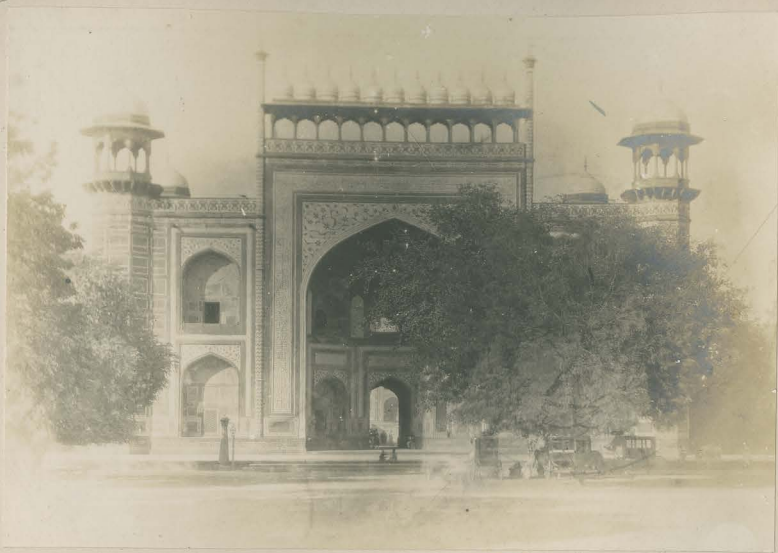


Victoria Memorial Delhi, erected to commemorate

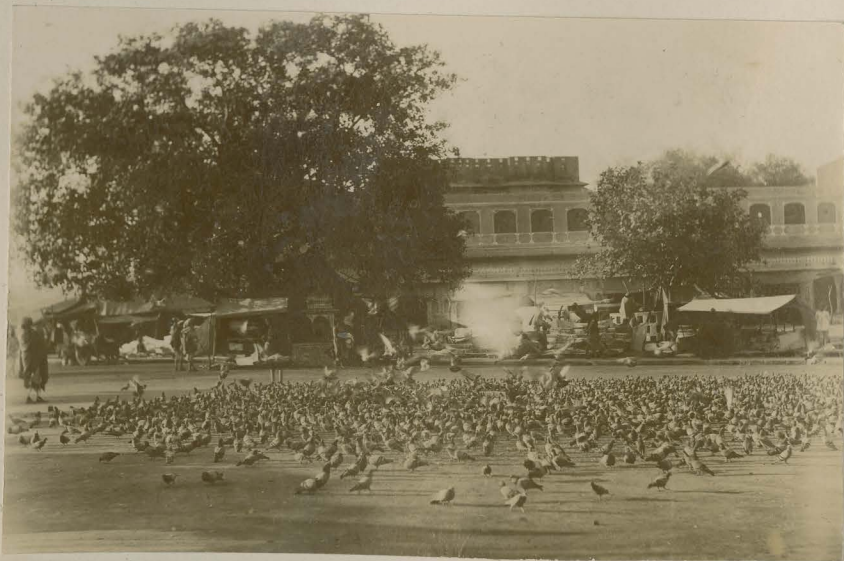
