In 1964 Dr. Hayden wrote "Physical Fitness for the Mentally Retarded" (Frank considered the word retarded as offensive to him but it was the reference at the time) He asked the Rotary Clubs that had originally funded his research for \$1,000 to print 1,000 copies of the Volume. He planned to give away 500 and distribute the rest for \$2.00 apiece so clubs could get their money back. In the

end, more than 50,000 copies were sold. A copy made its way south and landed in the hands of Eunice Kennedy Shriver, Joseph P. Kennedy Jr. Foundation

The personal documents and press clippings in this file reveal valuable historical evidence of Dr. Hayden's work to improve the quality of life for people with an intellectual disability. Dr. Hayden demonstrated that many long held professional medical assumptions that intellectual disabled persons had low fitness levels as a direct result of their disabilities were incorrect. While in Washington he worked tirelessly to change public attitudes, taboos and perceptions that people with an intellectual disability could not contribute to society. But more importantly, he opened a world of opportunity for people with an intellectual disability to improve their fitness levels and participate in sports to the best of their ability and by doing so they greatly improved their self image and confidence.
