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In order to improve access to more of the existing holdings of Western Archives copies of a number of preliminary finding aids are being made available. These preliminary finding aids, some of which were prepared many years ago, vary in degrees of completeness, detail and accuracy. Some provide only basic box listings of the contents of a fonds or a collection, while others provide additional background material. All are intended to be the starting point for access to the records and they should not be considered a definitive source of information on the full nature and contents of the fonds or collection. 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Labatt Family Papers

Biographical History:

John Sackville Labatt was born in London Ontario on March 10th, 1880. He was the grandson of John Kinder Labatt, who founded Labatt's Brewery which John S. later became president of in 1915. John was educated at Trinity College in Port Hope and later received his BSC from McGill University in Montreal. In 1926 John married Elizabeth Anne Lynch.

Elizabeth or Bessie, as she was known, was born on June 24th, 1891. Elizabeth was a graduate of the McGill University Library School, she gave up her career to marry John. Both John and Elizabeth were active mambers in society. He was a member of the London Club, the Toronto Club and the London Hunt and Country Club. Elizabeth was an active member of the St. John's Ambulance, Nursing Division for Southwestern Ontario. She became Lady District Superintendent in 1942 and in 1952 became Dame of Grace, the highest rank possible with the St. John's Ambulance. Mrs. Labatt was also the founding member of the Family Service Bureau in London. Mr. and Mrs. Labatt had three children; John Pridam, Mary Elizabeth and William Arthur Sackville. John S. Labatt died on July 8th, 1952 and Elizabeth died over twenty years later on February 19th, 1975.

Custodial History:

The custodial history of the Labatt Family fonds is unknown.

Scope and Content:

The fonds consists of two series, the textual and photographics series. The files of the textual series consists predominantly of Elizabeth Labatt's activities, in an official compacity with the St. John Ambulance consisting of such items as correspondence, minutes of meetings, pamphlets, financial papers and her personal journals.

The photographic materials consists of files for the Labatt, Amesbury, Denham, Zollicoffer and various friends and family members to Elizabeth Labatt. As well, there are many unidentified photographs.

Scope and Content:

File contains two newsclippings. One is a section from <u>Saturday Night</u> October 29, 1927 which has a photograph of Elizabeth's parents Mr. and Mrs. W.J. Lynch celebrating their golden wedding anniversary. There is also an article and photograph of Lady Mowat, wife of Sir Oliver Mowat. The other newsclipping is from the <u>Ottawa Journal</u> October 29, 1955. It contains an article entitled "The Story of Earnscliff" with a photograph of the room where Sir John A. Macdonald died. Underneath this photograph is written " and I slept here when Clutterbacks? were in residence - 5 days one visit 3 days another".
