8<sup>th</sup> Troop formed on December 1, 1910.

He joined the 8<sup>th</sup> Troop on Dec 1, 1910 and was invented/invited (?) and enrolled on this same day.

Born October 1, 1882 – Died \_\_\_\_, 19\_\_.

Appointed Assistant Scoutmaster on Dec 1, 1910 but not sworn in; warrant issues on Nov 21, 1911.

8<sup>th</sup> Troop originally comprised of boys from Dundas Street Centre United Church, but later (19??) became non-denominational.
