To use the ST ViewScan Micro (black) scanners:

• Load the microfilm/fiche as per the posted instructions.

Getting Started:

- Click View Scan Premium to enter the scanning program, if needed
- Click anywhere to proceed
- There are three modes of operation:
 - o Simple
 - Standard choose this mode
 - Advanced
- Use the buttons on the scanner OR on screen to advance/rewind
- Move carriage forward or backward to view top/bottom of film/fiche.

Viewing:

- Across the top banner are three Modes:
 - File: to save or export your image(s)
 - Browse: to find and view image(s) (auto selected)
 - Crop: to select your image(s).
- In Browse Mode there are several Tools:
 - o Rotate, Flip, Mirror: to change the direction of the text
 - o Auto focus, Zoom In/Zoom Out, + or : to focus the image
 - Adjust Image: to change the brightness/contrast
 - Inversion: to change between negative or positive, depending on your microform.
- Settings: Opaque Micro: use ONLY for micro cards.

Image Capture:

- In Crop Mode:
- At bottom screen:
 - Capture Full Frame: captures entire on screen image
 - Capture Cropped Area greyed out until something cropped. To crop image click the Cropping tab (top banner) then drag borders around area to capture.
- Once image(s) are chosen they gather in the Image Bin at bottom of screen.

To Print/Export:

- Click FILE mode
- Choose PRINT, Save or Email.
 - o To Print:
 - Goes to Weldon printers located in Print Copy Centre at front entrance
 - Cost is 10 ¢ per image/page
 - Black & White only
 - Sent under machine name, look on Desktop for print icon, e.g.



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- To Save:
 - To a USB
 - Choose format. PDF, JPEG, PNG or TIF file
- Email:
 - Western Faculty, Staff or Students, save to desktop first
 - o Alumni or Guests, See staff for assistance.
